Re: COVID-19 Waiver Requests

Dear Sir or Madam:

Thank you for your email to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) confirming the coverage of skilled nursing facility (SNF) care in rural hospitals through the swing bed program under the 1135 waiver authority.

Under this waiver, CAHs and rural (non-CAH) swing-bed hospitals may move patients from their acute care beds to swing beds for extended care services without a 3-day prior hospitalization. The Social Security Act permits CAHs and rural (non-CAH) swing-bed hospitals to enter into a swing bed agreement, under which the hospital can use its beds, as needed, to provide either acute or SNF care. Rural (non-CAH) hospitals are paid under the SNF prospective payment system (PPS) for their SNF-level swing-bed services. By contrast, CAH swing-bed services are not subject to the SNF PPS. Instead, Medicare pays CAHs based on 101 percent of reasonable cost for their swing-bed services.
